Since its inception, we have seen remarkable growth and engagement. More students are exploring careers in construction. More educators are connecting individuals with opportunities to build their careers in the construction industry. More employers are finding the entry-level talent they need to grow their companies from within.

On behalf of the National Center for Construction Education and Research, we want to celebrate their investment and highlight the measurable impact they are making by helping us change lives through construction education.

In 2024, we made a notable change to the platform host to software that offers a mobile application, which enhances accessibility and the user experience. In addition, we tracked applications submitted through CareerStarter to help measure connections to construction careers. These new features are helping refine our platform to better meet the needs of all users.

Through strong partnerships with industry, education and communities, CareerStarter is helping individuals build their futures and making great strides in bridging the workforce gap. We saw 590 applications submitted and 142 job placements in 2024. We are proud of all we have accomplished and look forward to continued growth in the coming year.
